Pastor Paul writes -

'And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you' –
Luke 24:49

Last month we started looking at the amazing truth that we have the Holy Spirit! (We receive him at conversion), fulfilling the promise of the new covenant. But we long for and need more experience of him, to live the Christian life successfully. And the church needs more of his power to successfully preach the gospel. Jonathan Edwards tells us more...

This [the sending of the Holy Spirit] being the great blessing Christ purchased by his labours and sufferings on earth, it was this which he received of the Father when he ascended into heaven, and entered into the holy of holies with his own blood, that he might pass this on to those whom he had redeemed. John 16:7. "It is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you."

Acts 2:33. "Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing"—

This is the sum of those gifts, which Christ received for men, even for the rebellious, at his ascension; and of the benefits Christ obtains for men by his intercession; John 14:16, 17. "I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth"

Herein consists Christ's sharing fulness, his being full of the Spirit; and so full of grace and truth, that we might of this fulness receive, and grace for grace. He is anointed with the Holy Spirit, and this is the ointment that goes down from the head to the members (Psa 133). "God gives the Spirit without measure to him, that every member might receive according to the measure of the gift of Christ" John 3:34, Eph 4:7.

This therefore was the great blessing he prayed for in that wonderful prayer which he uttered for his disciples and all his future church, the evening before he died in John 17. The blessing he prayed for to the Father, on behalf of his disciples, was the same he had insisted on in his previous teaching with them; and this, doubtless, was the blessing he prayed for, when, as our High Priest, he offered up strong crying and tears, with his blood, Heb. 5:6, 7. As for this he shed his blood, for this he also shed tears, and poured out prayers – this sending of the Spirit.
